1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the club bulletin board and at registration.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all PHRF rated boats.
- 3.2 Expected PHRF Fleets: A (less than 150), B (150 to 199); C (200 and above).
- 3.3 Multihull boats must be sixteen (16) feet or over in length.
- 3.4 A minimum of two (2) boats will constitute a fleet.
- 3.5 Eligible boats may enter by remitting the required fee at registration.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$15 per boat.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 One (1) race is scheduled.

- 6.1 The racing area will be located on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay.
- 6.2 Courses will be to/through the MidBay Bridge and back using Government, Club, or temporary marks.
- 6.3 Courses will be available at the Skippers Meeting.

RRS 3 Decision to Race states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' The Fort Walton Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1 Fleet winner names will be engraved on the MidBay Bridge Perpetual Trophy.
- 8.2 Additional awards may be presented based on the number of entries per fleet.
- 8.3 The awards ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the race.
